**RESTRICTIONS TO SKIP – BLACK BAGS ONLY**

As per the Annual General Meeting held on 27/11/2013 it was resolved that all occupants of Central Park have to comply to with the Mbombela by laws with regards to Refuse and Refuse Removal.

From the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2013 only one bin bag of refuse in a sealed Black Bin Bag will be allowed to be deposited in the central skip per unit per day. Under **NO** circumstances will any industrial refuse or packaging be acceptable.

It is each company's responsibility to remove all industrial rubbish, packaging and other refuse from Central Park at their own expense. There are numerous recycling companies in Nelspruit and we suggest that you investigate these options. For those occupants that are not aware, there is a recycling facility across the road from Central Park entrance.

The rubbish area will be monitored by camera and offenders will be fined R500 per offence should they contravene the above .

**MBOMBELA LOCAL MUNICIPALITY WASTE MANAGEMENT BY-LAWS SOLID WASTES AND SANITARY BY-LAWS ADMINISTRATOR'S NOTICE NO. 1171 (16 AUGUST 1978)**

"6.1 (a) all the domestic or business refuse generated on the premises is placed and kept in bin liners for removal by the Council: "

"(6.3) The bin liners containing refuse shall be removed by the Council only if such bin liner has been placed at the prescribed place, as provided for in section 5, at such intervals as the Council may deem necessary."

Please comply to the new refuse rules of the Park to avoid unnecessary fines.
